



Student Travel Award Reimbursement (S.T.A.R.) Program Application Information – Washington State

Two Application Deadlines Annually: January 1 and September 1 at Midnight ET

Through a generous donation from the Washington Society of Audiology (WSA), the American Academy of Audiology Foundation is offering fulltime audiology graduate students (AuD, PhD, AuD/PhD) from a **Washington state-based university** funding to support their participation in professional meetings where they will present research or gain an educational experience not available in their academic program. Selected students will receive a stipend of up to \$500 for conference registration, transportation, and/or lodging expenses for meetings in the hearing sciences or other sciences relating to student coursework.

Students who receive funding through this WSA funded S.T.A.R. program are required to provide the Foundation with a post-conference statement (2-3 paragraphs) that details the experience and learning outcomes within 30 days following the meeting. Recipients are also encouraged to send photographs (.jpeg format) with their post-conference statements for use on the Foundation Web site and in other media.

A committee of audiologists will review application materials, and award notification will be made by February 15 and October 15 respectively.

Eligibility, Guidelines, and Conditions

1. Students must be fulltime audiology graduate students (AuD, PhD, AuD/PhD) at a Washington-based university at the time of the conference.
2. Students presenting their own research are given preference in S.T.A.R. program funding.
3. Students can only receive one S.T.A.R. program stipend during their graduate school career.
4. Stipends constitute a reimbursement for expenses incurred and will be made following conference attendance and the submittal of appropriate documentation.
5. Students are required to notify the Foundation if they have applied for and/or have received funding from other sources. S.T.A.R. funding is not intended for use when other mechanisms of support have already been provided/received to cover conference expenses.

Applicants are required to submit the following:

1. Completed application (attached)
2. Letter of recommendation from a departmental faculty member supporting the applicant's attendance at this specific conference and verifying the applicant's standing in the program. Please explain how attendance at this conference will advance the student's future career.
3. Personal statement that explains why the applicant wishes to attend the conference and how it relates to the applicant's course of study (500 words maximum).
4. Curriculum and/or agenda of the meeting the applicant wishes to attend.
5. Abstract of research poster/presentation and brief description of the applicant's role in research project (optional).

NOTE: Please read the submission criteria carefully. ONLY send the information requested above; applicants who send unrequested documentation may be disqualified from consideration.
